ANNUAL REPORT HIGHLIGHTS ON GRANT AND CONTRACT ACTIVITY FISCAL YEAR 2006

OVERVIEW

AWARDS

The University of Oregon received \$96.5 million from external funding sources in grants, contracts and other competitive awards for fiscal year 2005-06. This represents the highest total in award dollars ever recorded at the UO, as shown on the awards chart "A Multi-Year Summary of Public and Private Support".

Direct federal funding to UO totaled \$64.8 million. Direct federal funding plus sub-federal dollars (sub-federal funds are "flow-through" dollars allocated by other entities, such as universities, non-profits, and state and local governmental agencies, to the UO in support of research) totaled \$83.1 million in FY06. Federal funding accounted for 86% of the total funding received by the UO in FY06, as shown in the awards charts. Funding from the National Science Foundation increased by 22% to \$17.2 million, while support from the U.S. Department of Education decreased by 9%. Support from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, including the National Institutes of Health, remained steady at \$24 million. A significant increase was realized in FY06 from the U.S. Department of Energy (a 26% increase to nearly \$3.9 million). While support from the U.S. Department of Defense appears to have increased significantly (a 372% increase to \$7 million), this was due to the fact that the first of two increments of an incrementally funded award was received late, so that both increments were received and counted in the same fiscal period, FY06.

Private foundations and corporations provided funds totaling \$5.2 million, and support from all private sponsors, including non-governmental entities that pass-through federal funds to UO, totaled \$10.1 million. State of Oregon agencies awarded grants and contracts to the UO totaling nearly \$15.6 million, from both state funds and sub-federal pass-through funds.

A total of 564 awards were made to 219 faculty serving as principal investigators (PI) in fiscal year 2005-06. The College of Education received \$29.6 million and the College of Arts and Sciences received \$13 million in FY06. Research centers and institutes under the Vice President for Research received \$48.3 million. Details on awards received by college and submitting unit, over several years, are found in the awards charts.

Tenured and tenure-track faculty are generally appointed through an academic department, where instruction, public service and some research activities are their primary functions. However, interdisciplinary research and collaboration is a hallmark at the UO, and many faculty members manage their externally-funded research programs through a research center or institute. The proposals are submitted by, and awards are made to, the centers and institutes as opposed to the academic unit. Charts on "Awards by Proposal Submitting Unit" and "Awards by Home Unit of the PI and Co-PI" reflect this breakdown. For example, the research centers and institutes that report to the Vice President for Research are attributed with 50% of total award

dollars, whereas 54% of the PIs and Co-PIs are appointed in academic departments of the College of Arts and Sciences. Another chart provides details on award totals for faculty by home unit (the academic department where the PI or Co-PI is appointed), reflecting the strength of faculty research in their various academic departments.

Awards are categorized as primarily supporting research, instruction, or public service activities. Grants and contracts in FY06 are reported by their primary purpose as follows:

Research \$66.9 million (70%)
 Instruction \$6.2 million (6%)
 Public Service \$23.5 million (24%)

PROPOSALS

Over 800 proposals were submitted requesting \$111.7 million in first-year funding. Eighty percent of total proposal submissions were for new and competitive renewal grants, requesting \$85.1 million in first-year funding. Sixty-two percent of total proposal submissions requested federal support totaling \$95.9 million, or 85.5% of total dollars requested. The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, including the National Institutes of Health, accounted for almost half of the federal dollars requested, while the U.S. Department of Education was 21% and the National Science Foundation was 19.7% of federal support requested.

Proposals submitted to private foundations and corporations represented 17% of the total proposal submissions, requesting \$7.4 million or 6.6% of total dollars requested.

EXPENDITURES

Expenditures on approximately 1300 active grants and contracts during the 2005-06 fiscal year totaled a record \$95.7 million for direct and F&A (indirect) costs. Expenditure totals do not match the award totals for the same fiscal year, as grants are received and reported during a fiscal year but the funds can be spent over multiple fiscal years. Personnel costs represented 61% of direct expenditures, or \$48 million, with another \$30.4 million spent for services, supplies, equipment and miscellaneous project-related expenses. Research activities accounted for 65% of the total expenditures, while training and other sponsored programs accounted for the remaining 35%.

FACILITIES AND ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS

Facilities and Administrative (F&A) or indirect cost recovery totaled \$17.3 million in FY06. The federally-negotiated F&A rate budgeted for research activities was 48.5% (other activities use different rates or do not allow F&A to be charged), but only 18% of actual expenditures in FY06 was for F&A costs, resulting in a significantly lower "effective rate" for recovering facilities and administrative costs campus-wide. Of the total \$17.3 received for F&A costs,

59.3% of the total received was reallocated directly in support of faculty as costshare or matching funds, new faculty start up costs, and for other faculty research needs, as well as for research center and institute administration, specialized labs and shared research facilities. The remainder of F&A cost recovery supports general university administration, research administration, facilities maintenance and operations, OUS administration and new building costs. A breakdown of F&A funds received over time and allocations by cost component are found in the F&A charts.

Description of Award and Proposal Charts and Reports

Figure 1 shows the FY 2006 total awards received by agency type. Federal agencies awarded UO 67% of the 2006 total, and sub-federal or flow-through federal funds accounted for 19% of the 2006 total. Associations, States, Foundations, Corporations, and Other agencies amounted to a total of 14% of the 2006 total.

Figure 2 shows the federal and sub-federal funding to UO by federal agency. U.S. Department of Education, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, and the National Science Foundation were the top three agencies from which UO received awards in FY 2006.

Figure 3 provides a multi-year summary of public and private support. Awards are compared over a 20-year span in the categories of Direct Federal funds, Private funds, Oregon funds, and Other funds.

Figure 4 shows awards received over a 3-year period by Activity type: Research, Instruction, and Public Service.

Figure 5 shows FY 2006 proposals, awards, and expenditures by Research and Other Activity types.

Figure 6 spans five years to show the fluctuation in awards received and proposals submitted over the period.

Figure 15 shows the amount of funding requested by application type.





DOLLARS REQUESTED BY AGENCY TYPE




DOLLARS REQUESTED BY FEDERAL AGENCY




FY 06 PROPOSAL SUBMISSIONS

REQUESTED FUNDING BY APPLICATION TYPE












